
NOTICE

Sirs/ Mesdames:

Please take notice that in HRET Case No. 13-032 (EP), *Richard Venancio Fernando V. Ziga vs. Edcel B. Lagman, Jr. (First District, Albay)*, the Tribunal issued Resolution No. 13-087 dated August 15, 2013, which reads as follows:

On May 31, 2013, protestant filed a *Petition* (Election Protest) of even date contesting the election results in the City of Tabaco and Municipality of Bacacay. On June 20, 2013, however, protestant filed a *Motion to Withdraw* the instant election protest dated June 10, 2013 on the ground that "the instant election protest is an exercise in futility considering the fact that this protest will be rendered moot and academic should the disqualification case against the protestee prosper and (be) granted by final judgment."

WHEREFORE, the Tribunal **GRANTS** protestant's *Motion to Withdraw* dated June 10, 2013. This case is considered **CLOSED** and **TERMINATED**.
